MSHA completed the review of your application for hose cover using compound "1315." The application was dated April 23, 2012, with Company Code No. 201201.

This construction and the information provided meet the requirements of Title 30 Code of Federal Regulations (30CFR) Part 18 and the Standard Application Procedures for Acceptance of Flame-Resistant Solid Products Taken into Mines.

The following requirements apply to this acceptance:

1. Acceptance Marking "**MSHA 2G-IC-62C**" must be permanently marked on the product with letters at least 1/4" high and at intervals not exceeding 3 feet. Other types of permanent markings may be used with prior approval of MSHA.
2. The accepted material thickness range is 0.9 mm to 1.4 mm.
3. You are obligated, as the manufacturer, to maintain the quality of the product to assure the requirements of this acceptance are being met.
4. Any change in product composition or in any other factors that may affect this acceptance must not be made without prior authorization from MSHA.
5. We have the right to revoke this acceptance for cause at any time.
6. This acceptance applies to use as cover on fire suppression hose and as cover on hydraulic hose.

An invoice for the cost of processing this action will be forthcoming.
